The School Day

School starts at 8.45am. Lunch time is 12.00-1.00pm. School ends at 3.15pm.

Please be punctual both arriving and collecting your children. If you are unavoidably delayed please contact the school office. Staff will be in the playground to meet children and parents both at the start and the end of the day.

<u>Lunchtimes</u>

School meals are to be paid for via IRIS parentmail. A school lunch is priced at \pounds 2.20. Alternatively you may provide your child with a packed lunch. If you think that you may be entitled to free school meals please ask at the office.

The Curriculum

At Simonside, every Year 3/4 child has a daily maths and literacy lesson. Literacy lessons involve the children developing their writing, reading, speaking and listening skills. The children also take part in drama activities to help stimulate ideas for written work. We will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction books that link in with the topics for each half term.

In Year 3/4, the children have 4 numeracy lessons with the class teacher which involves all aspects of mathematics work including mental and written calculations.

Topic maps are on the school website for each class for each term. Where possible we try to link topic work in with the other subjects the children are doing. Please have a look at our Class Dojo as regularly as you can – we will keep you up to date on what we've been learning in class.

<u>Homework</u>

Homework tasks will be set weekly. This work will be based on what we have done in class and will not be new to the children. It will be set at a level that children can access for themselves; they may need encouragement to do their homework but shouldn't need help to complete it. All children should please ask for support at school (before the homework deadline) if they have been unable to complete their homework. Homework will be set on a **Friday** and returned the following **Wednesday**. It is expected that all homework tasks will be completed and returned to school on time. If homework is not completed and returned to school for the deadline, you will be made aware via Class Dojo.

The children will also be expected to learn spellings and times tables weekly. It would also be beneficial if they could practise their multiplication tables as often as possible as there is now a multiplication check in Year 4. By the end of year 3, there is an expectation that children will be able to recall the 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times table. Finally, if you could listen to your child read at home, or ask them questions about what they are reading this would be very highly effective in securing progress.

Important days and dates for this academic year

Tuesday and Friday – PE (children can come to school in their PE kits on these days).

Friday – Homework, spellings and reading books given out.

Wednesday – Homework, reading books and reading records to be returned

P.E. kit consists of a grey t-shirt, black shorts and plimsolls. Trainers will also be needed for outdoor P.E. in September and the warmer months. It will be noted down if children don't have their P.E. kit (including P.E. shoes) and if this happens 3 times across a half term then you will be contacted via Class Dojo.

<u>Fruit and Drink</u>

KS2 Children can bring in fruit to eat at break time.

Children can bring in a water bottle with water (no metal bottles).

We believe that children should take regular drinks of water throughout the school day. Children should bring a water bottle to school, clearly marked with their name. They will also have access to water in the classroom. No juice or flavoured water.

Absence from School

If your child is absent from school, parents must telephone the school office by 09:30.

- Contact school as soon as possible to let us know the reason why your child is absent and how long they are likely to be off for.
- Without an explanation the absence will be marked as UNAUTHORISED.
- Children should not return to school for 48 hours after the last occurrence of sickness.
- Please arrange to take family holidays during school holidays. Permission will not be given for holidays during term time.
- Please try to organise all Dentist and non-urgent Doctors' appointments outside of school time
