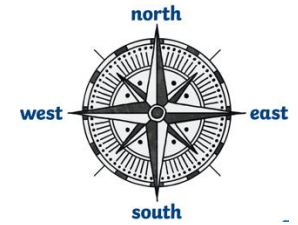




Continents



Key Knowledge

- There are seven continents: Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australasia, Europe, North America and South America.
- Some continents have many countries, others do not.
- Europe is the second smallest continent. It has around 44 countries, including England.
- There are five oceans in the world: the Arctic Ocean, the Atlantic Ocean, the Indian Ocean, the Pacific Ocean and the Southern Ocean.
- Natural features of continents include caves, rocks, cliffs, forests and mountains. These can be called 'physical features'.
- Features made by people include bridges, buildings and roads. These features are called 'human features'.
