Online Safety at Christmas

As some children may be receiving new consoles or games at Christmas, here is a quick reminder of the importance of setting up appropriate parental controls on these devices.

Games/Consoles

- Check age ratings: Look at the PEGI rating. Many popular games have content that's not suitable for younger ages. The safest long-term solution



- is to adjust the device's setting so they can only download and use games appropriate for their age.
- Manage communication: Check whether games include communication features. If a game does allow your child to communicate with others, then adjust or disable the settings as appropriate to your child.
- Set device controls: On the device itself, set up spending limits and other parental controls. Most consoles allow you to customise their settings to determine which games your child can play and what content they can access:
